DAY CAMP HOURS

Camp: 8:30am - 4:30pm

Before Care: 8am – 8:30am

After Care: 4:30pm – 5pm

BEFORE/AFTER CARE:

Before care is free & must be registered for ahead of time and is available from 8am – 8:30am.

After care is available for an additional fee of \$10/ half hour. Online registration required in advance. Please contact the gym directly for last-minute requests

BE PREPARED FOR CAMP:

1. Bring refillable water bottle, nutritious nut-free lunch with plenty of snacks.
2. Tie back long hair, remove jewelry & wear or bring socks, fitted athletic clothing without buckles, zippers or buttons.
3. WEDNESDAYS: Bring hat, sunscreen, swimsuit and towel, running shoes and bag for wet items.
4. Campers must be able to use the washroom, apply sunscreen & open all food containers independently.

PLEASE DON'T BRING:

Cell phones, gaming devices, iPods, iPads/ tablets, toys or money. If any of these items arrive at camp, staff will store them safely until pick-up.

DAY CAMP PARENT INFORMATION LETTER

Welcome to Vertical Zone Day Camp where kids take flight, both literally and figuratively! In addition to approximately 5+ hours of instructional trampoline and in gym time per day, there are weekly field trips, special guest entertainers & creative activities to keep campers engaged during their rest time. Campers will learn about themselves, others and the world around them through activities that match their age, interests, needs & abilities.

DROP OFF & PICK UP:

On the first day of camp please allow extra time for staff to confirm completion of online forms and review permitted pick-up personnel, emergency contact information and health & medical information (if applicable).

1. Before care begins at 8:00am, those signed up for Before Care can check in as early as 7:50am. For campers not registered for Before Care, camp begins at 8:30am with doors opening and check-in beginning at 8:20.
2. Our camp day ends at 4:30pm with all campers needing to be checked out by 4:35pm. Pick-up for those who have registered for after care is 5:00pm
3. Sign your camper into camp with staff located in the front lobby. Parents/ guardians or authorized persons must sign their campers in and out. Please be patient on your first day of check-in, as all camper information will need to be verified.
4. Photo ID must be available upon request to sign camper(s) out at the end of each camp day. This is for the safety of your campers. Please be prepared to show ID until staff are familiar with the adults approved for pick up.
5. Campers 10 years of age and older who have a **Release Authorization Form** signed, may sign themselves out. We ask that they wait in the building until they see their person has arrived for pick up.
6. Any exceptions/ changes to the sign-out procedure rules must be approved in advance by the camp director. No exceptions will be made regarding photo ID

CAMPER SAFETY & SECURITY:

To help ensure a safe and successful camp experience, **all medical information and required forms must be completed and submitted before your camper's first day of camp.**

If your child has any medical, social, emotional, or behavioural exceptionalities that may require accommodations, please complete and submit our **Health & Medication Form** prior to the start of camp.

Please note that **Vertical Zone is unable to provide one-to-one (1:1) support.** We are happy to accommodate approved agency support workers when arrangements have been made in advance.

Medications: Any medication that needs to be administered during camp must be in its original container, clearly labeled with the camper's name and dosage instructions. Please give all medications directly to the Camp Director during morning check-in.

CAMP STAFF:

At Vertical Zone, our camp staff are selected for their maturity, experience, and ability to work with children. All staff complete pre-camp training in leadership, safety, and emergency procedures. Any non-Vertical Zone staff on site are approved agency support workers assisting campers with exceptionalities.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Photos, videos, & audio may be taken for Vertical Zone's promotional & educational purposes. Contact the Camp Director regarding any concerns.
- Vertical Zone is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Campers should be able to carry their bags comfortably & keep track of their belongings.
- If campers struggle with personal care or following staff direction that jeopardizes the safety of themselves & others, withdrawal
- Please label belongings.

PROGRAM:

VZ staff reserves the right to modify & change programming structure of the camp to *accommodate a variety of needs*.

WEDNESDAY FIELD DAY & SWIMMING: Each Wednesday, campers will travel by **Barrie Transit** and **Barrie Transit On Demand** to and from the Peggy Hill Team Community Centre for our Field Day and swimming activities. These outings are intentionally overstaffed to provide additional supervision, ensuring a safe, organized, and enjoyable experience for all campers throughout the trip.

PIZZA PARTY FRIDAYS: Included with all full week and Friday single day registrations. This is optional but campers who wish to partake will receive 2 slices of either pepperoni or cheese pizza, a nut and gluten free fruit snack and a nut-free granola bar. Dairy free and gluten free pizzas can be accommodated at a cost.

WITHDRAWALS OR REFUNDS:

Gymnastics Ontario (GO) Insurance Fee: The Gymnastics Ontario (GO) Insurance Fee is non-refundable and provides your camper with recreational athlete insurance coverage for the **2026/27 season** (valid until **June 30, 2027**). This fee is automatically added to registrations for campers attending **one full week of camp or more than four individual camp days**. Once paid, you will not be charged this fee again when registering for any future camps or recreational programs during the 2026/27 season.

Withdrawals: Withdrawal requests received **14 or more days before** the program start date are eligible for a refund, less a **10% cancellation fee**. The cancellation fee applies **per registration**. Refund requests made within 14 days of the program start date will only be considered if accompanied by a medical note and will still be subject to the 10% cancellation fee.

Cancellations Within 7 Days: Cancellation or refund requests made **within 7 days** of the program start date are not eligible for a refund. Camp day or week exchange requests may be accommodated **up to 14 days before** the program start date, subject to availability, at no additional charge.
